All Pre entries Must be postmarked on or before April 22, 2015

Entries post-marked BEFORE OPENING DATES, will not be accepted. Entries will be accepted by postmark order.

In the event of duplicate postmark dates, a drawing will determine which entry will be accepted.

After entry is accepted, refunds will not be made. Run order will be determined by random draw in advance of the trial.

Bitches in season will run as drawn. Substitutions will be allowed. The substitute dog must be owned by the original entrant.

Day of trial entries, if available, will be taken at 7:30 am on all trial days. Gate entries will go last.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Lunch and beverage items will be available on site at a reasonable cost.
2. *Dogs must be kept on leash when not working. Please clean up after your dog.*
3. Entry forms can be obtained from the ASCA website (www.asca.org) under 'Forms & Rulebooks.'
4. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations.
5. All ASCA approved herding breeds are eligible and welcome to enter!
If you are not an ASCA member, you must have a tracking number from ASCA - Forms available at www.asca.org .
6. Dogs must enter in started and progress through advanced.
7. Entry fees will not be returned if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of public enemy, strikes or other causes beyond the control of the Twin Creek Farm.
8. Any entries received postmarked after April 22, 2015 will be placed on the waiting list, in the order of receipt. Additions will be made prior to the start of the trial from the waiting list and are at the discretion of Course Director.
9. Entry fees will not be returned in the event that a dog is absent
10. **In the event that any dog is deemed absent prior to closing date of April 22, 2015, its trial slot(s) will be filled from the waiting list. Entry fees will not be returned unless filled from waiting list and someone takes your run. Any entry fee(s) will be returned to the original entrant. Substitutions will be allowed only with a dog owned by the same person making the original entry**
11. Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock. At stock owners option, dog's owner will pay for veterinarian services, or if necessary replace.
12. This trial will be run under ASCA rules and regulations.
13. Owner/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing.

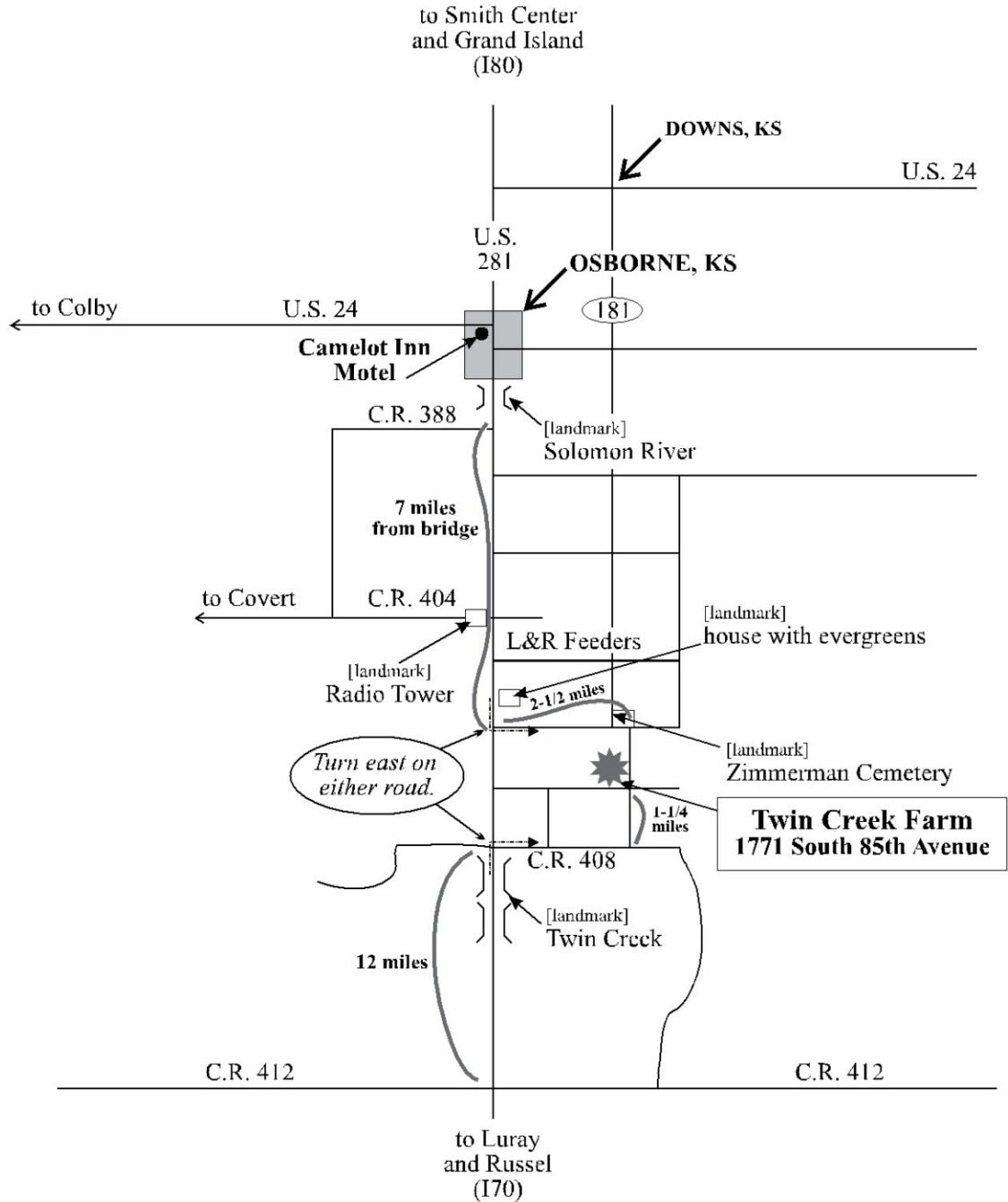

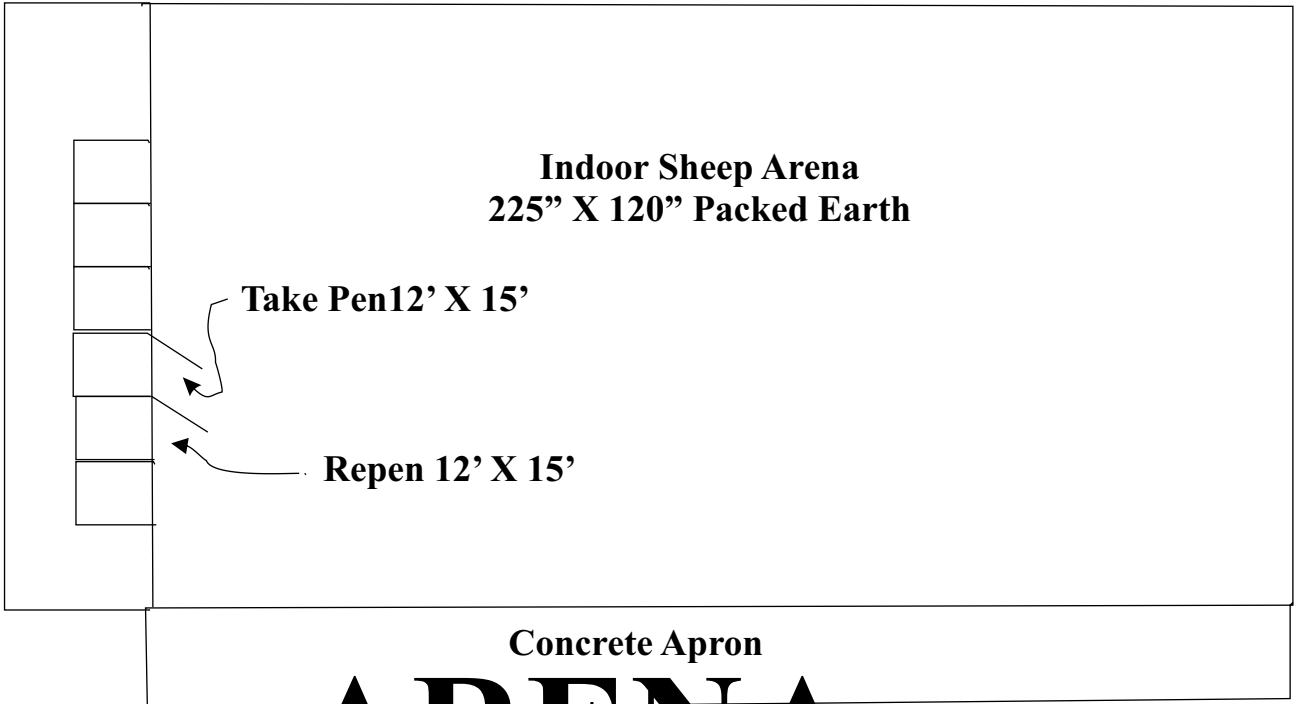
